MaxSil[™] Application & Dosage

MAXSIL™: APPLICATION: MaxSil™ is available in both powder and granule form. Powder can be applied directly to the soil, followed by watering it in, or by mixing it first with water in a watering can by applying it directly to the soil, i.e. not over the plants. Granules can be applied directly to the soil.

MAXSIL™ DOSAGE: General use: 20 grams (g) per square metre (m2). Increase dosage by 50% for soils with a high organic content, e.g. rich in compost. Only one dosage is required per growing season.

Measurement tools: 1 level measuring teaspoon (tsp) = 5g; 1 level measuring tablespoon (tbs) = 15g; 1 measuring cup = 250g. Note: overdosing does NO harm.

Vegetable gardens: Before planting mix 250g of MaxSil powder in a 9 litre watering can to spray over 12.5 m2; alternatively, sprinkle $\frac{1}{4}$ to $\frac{1}{2}$ tsp around each seedling or plant & water in well.

Plant pots: $\frac{1}{2}$ tsp to 2 tsp of powder per pot (small to large) & water in well.

Lawns: 20 g/m2; granules: 1 cup covers 12.5 m2; or mix 1 cup of powder in a 9 litre watering can to cover 12.5 m2.

Trees and Shrubs/Ornamentals, including citrus, bananas, nuts, papaya: Granules or powder as for lawns above; apply within drip line of large trees.
